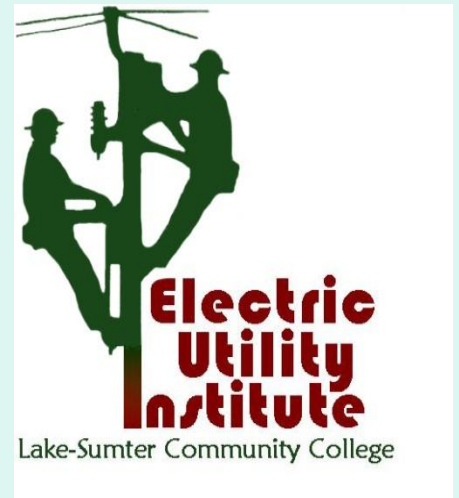


Lake-Sumter Community College Electric Utility Institute

Electrical Distribution Technology

- Program was initiated at the request and with the support of local electric utility industry partners.
- Enrolled 60 apprentices from 3 local utilities; 47 have earned certificates and/or degrees.
- Spring of 2009 – open enrollment classes (evenings and Saturdays).

Lineworker “Boot Camp”

- Six-week, 240-hour training program.
- Students may articulate 9 college credits into the college credit certificate program.
- 101 Boot Camp participants; 89 completers; 73 placements
- Boot camp planned for Spring 2010
 - Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch
